Paul Adamczyk of Marina Dr approached the board again regarding the spraying of Mosquitos. The Mayor indicated that he had a meeting with Dufalo's and the Mayor agrees that they are doing everything they should be doing he read a letter that Dufalo's presented to the Mayor. The Mayor informed Paul Adamczyk that the Village will continue to spray for mosquitos. Mr. Adamczyk indicating he would be pursuing this further.

Owners of 212 13th Ave were in with concerns about how dirty the beach has been and asked if the village is doing anything different. It was explained that with the high waters more than normal stuff is coming into shore. They also asked if there was a business model for Sylvan Beach. The Mayor recapped what is happening with the village.
